Tom Young requested being able to purchase a tool to help him read the meters. It will especially be helpful when the meters have water in them. The council decided that he should go ahead with the purchase.

The council also was shown pictures of a "Solar Bee" which serves to aerate the lagoons. It would be something to be looked into in the future.

The Lyle Towne from the highway district requested that a back flow preventor for the new R.V. Dump being installed on the highway district ground.

Tom Young told the council we need to get some no trespassing signs for the lagoons.

He also purchased the road patch material to fix the roads when the weather turns warmer.

Tom also passed his test for Waste Water System Collection Operator License. Water at park-need some new valves and set up for automatic usage. Alarm at well needs lid and junction box at well needs a cover.

Send a letter to Elnora Price about hooking up house to sewer that is for sale.

Motion made by Eschlman and 2nd by R. Smith for adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the motion carried and meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
