

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
DIETRICH, IDAHO  
APRIL 7, 2008

The regular meeting of the city council was called to order by Mayor Heiken at 7:00 P.M. at Dietrich City Hall. Roll was called and those answering present were A. Eschliman, D. Ballard, T. Perron, and absent was J. Rodgers. Also, attending the meeting was John and Betty Peyman.

Correction to agenda was Brad Dotson and Jim Phillips would not be attending the meeting.

**Motion** was made by D. Ballard and 2<sup>nd</sup> by A. Eschliman to approve the minutes with the correction that T. Perron abstained from the vote on getting the spray due to his concern over what the price of the spray would be. All in favor and the motion carried.

Tom Young explained to the council about the spray that he wanted to buy was \$175.00 a pound with a minimum of 4 pounds per purchase. That would make this spray cost around \$700.00. Pat Thomas will come and look at what needs to be sprayed and recommend what he thinks we should use to spray the weeds.

John and Betty Peyman attended the meeting with a request for the city to put up a speed sign on 7<sup>th</sup> Street going East. He said that his daughter, dog had been run over by someone speeding down the street. Suggested that a speed sign of 25 MPH be put up to let folks know that they are still within the city limits.

The work at the park building will consist of putting the door back together, with angle iron on door and dead bolts.

Brad Dotson was unable to attend the meeting to represent the P & Z Commission. Mr. Hobdey, our city attorney, said we should not disband the P & Z because of the difficulty in reinstating it should we want it again. He said that they could do quarterly meetings unless something special came up that they would need to take care of.

Clerk, Iva Lee Green, requested an update for the Quick Books program she is using. **Motion** was made by D. Ballard and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to upgrade the Quick Books program. All in favor and the motion carried.

Clerk was instructed to call Jim Phillips about what he would suggest for and agenda for the Board Training Meeting.

The roads need to be graded. The council needs to see if can borrow or rent the schools road grader. Mayor Heiken would be able to do the grading so we would save some money by not having to hire a driver.

Also, need to put some gravel on the top end of alley down to Mr. Greenfield's home.

The streets need patching and should take about 15 bags of cold patch from Valley Paving. Tom Young will drive to Bellevue and purchase it.

Mayor Heiken reported that he answered the letters sent by Mrs. Ritter's 5<sup>th</sup> Grade class.

Earth Day is coming and would like to schedule a time to pick up trash around the town.

The council would like to see if can set up something for the 29<sup>th</sup> of April. Councilman Perron will talk to Mr. Hollingshead about having the school children clean up some of the trash at the park.

Councilwoman Eschliman talked with Linda Arrossa and sent her a copy of the list of charges and payments made on her account.

Ms. Eschliman will turn in a letter of resignation and will probably not be at the next council meeting.

Mr. Young also reported that he will need more Krobar and Round up to finish the spraying. He was also requesting the council look into and eye wash station at the well where he puts the Chlorine into the water system.

The council needs to look into buying some ramps for the truck so can haul the lawn mower up to the pump house to mow the weeds. It was also suggested that a hydrant be put up at the pump house.

Motion was made by T. Perron and 2<sup>nd</sup> by D. Ballard to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:45 P.M.
