

BID OPENING

The Bid Opening for the Dietrich Sewer Project was called to order at 1:00 P.M.

Present were Jeanetta Knowles, Mayor, Tim Conant, councilman, Willie Tuescher, Dave Waldren, Forsgren & Associates, Joe and Carleen Herring, Region IV.

Northwest Liner submitted bid of \$159,275.00 for schedule 2(Lagoon site)

W3 Waste Water submitted bid of \$323,473.15 for Schedule 1

Environmental Liner submitted bid of \$189,500.00 for Schedule 2.

Apparent low bidder for Schedule 1 is Northwest Liner with a bid of \$159,275.00

Apparent low bidder for Schedule 2 is W3 Wastewater with a bid of \$323,473.15

Construction budget is \$386,125.00 for material and \$40,000.00 for LMI hook-up(service lines).

Budget cash available is \$515,500.

Forsgren to take bids back to office and go through them and check for correct calculations.

With liners and Schedule 1 will be about \$482,748.15 spent thus far.
