The Ag Teacher at school has been contacted about building a little trailer to haul the lawn mower.

Roads have still not been graded. Will probably have to wait until Spring because of the snow.

A new person needs to be appointed to the empty council seat. Connie or Scott Anderson has been contacted. They need to be reminded for the next meeting.

Motion made by J. Rodgers and 2nd by D. Ballard to buy a new printer. All in favor and the motion carried. A laser jet printer was suggested to save on the amount of ink used. Clerk will purchase one when she goes to Twin Falls.

Motion made by J. Rodgers and 2nd by D. Ballard to set up automatic withdrawal for pre-authorized payment to USDA Rural Development for payment on bound. All in favor and the motion carried.

Back room at city hall. The council needs to find out for sure if the fire district no longer wants to store a truck there.

Daryl Ballard will respond to Wendy Jacquet about her concerns over the annexation of the Dietrich West Subdivision.

Report for Tom Young was made by Mayor Heiken. Most of the signs are up but will probably have to have a sign made stating Yield to north bound traffic to be put by the railroad tracks. D. Ballard will check into making the sign.

Motion made by J. Rodgers and 2nd by D. Ballard to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the meeting adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
