W. Southwick talked to Sheriff S. Southwick about prosecution for the city. Thought that any felony charges the prosecutor would have to take care of and in the case of the city bringing charges the city would have to take care of prosecution.

Craig Hobdey doesn't want to do prosecuting. Council needs to look into if need to have 2 attorneys on board for city representation.

D. Heiken discussed trying to get a grant from DEQ.

Snowmobilers have been using the Lagoon berms for jumping. A fence needs to be put up to protect the lagoons.

Ralph Towne wants a metes and bounds survey of donated property. A question was brought up about a fence that was put in and Mr. Towne wants to know how property was donated and stock tight fence needs to be put up between his property and the city lagoon property.

Step Report: maybe have 100feet left to get line finished. Discussed how much money we have left and trying to figure out some ways to stretch what little money we have to meet expenses.

Brought to the council attention that we cannot sell city streets but can vacate and trade. Found a deed at the school where many years ago the Highway District sold a portion of Lincoln Street to the school. Need to vacate that portion of 5th street going through school property and through C. Divine property and need to clear up the title of the portion of Lincoln Street that goes through the school.

4th Street had a warranty deed and after was vacated was sold to Chuck Starnes. When Mr. Regalado bought the property he purchased the piece of the old 4th Street the city is interested in acquiring.

Plan to get legal problem with 5th Street and Lincoln Street to the school board with the proper documentation to get titles cleared.

Rural Water Association Water and Wastewater Vendor Conference in Boise. Should be registered by Feb. 15. No one will be able to attend this year due to work.

Motion made by D. Heiken and 2nd by W. Perron to put and ad in the paper to hire a part-time maintenance person for water and wastewater. This would be about 1 or 2 days a week. The person would take care of things for water and wastewater maintenance. Some mechanical ability recommended and training for certification would be required. All in favor and the motion carried.

Motion made by Heiken and 2nd by Perron to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
