A new printer has been purchased from Office Max.

A light has been purchased and installed for the snow plow for State of Idaho Highway Department.

Yield to North Bound Traffic sign – information will be mailed to D. Ballard with cost and design. He will know more by next meeting.

Back room of city hall is being used to store the snow plow.

Old business- letter about the school well from DEQ. The school well is not adequate for a back up well. Concerning the school well the valve to distribution center needs to be capped off. Mr. Young will call DEQ to see what we have to do to abandon the school well as our back up well.

Grants have been found for engineering for a back up well. The council needs to get the information and apply.

We need a program for cross connections. That is something that needs to be developed in the near future. Need to check and make sure that we do not have any cross connections.

Hydrant at the highway office is un-metered and needs to have a meter installed as well as a back flow preventor put on the hydrant to prevent cross contamination.

Operator is not provided with rubber gloves and an apron. An eye wash station needs to be installed at the well. Line coming back into town can be tapped with a saddle to put in a station. Mr. Hiatt will do the work for about \$100.00.

A well log needs to be kept and need static well reading equipment. Static well levels need to be kept in a log book.

Jim Phillips can come to a work meeting the week of the 26<sup>th</sup>. The council decided January 28, 2009 at 7:00 P.M. to meet with Mr. Phillips.

Report from Tom Young- Shelter for generator- persons asked to call dig line and they cut through the phone line anyway. Phone Company had to come and fix the phone. Still need to raise the sides of the shelter to get the generator in and out. The brackets have already been purchased just need to have some flat plates to reinforce the part that is raised.

White Cloud Communication has been working with Tech Hut to bring reliable internet to small communities. Someone from Tech Hut will attend the next meeting.

Mr. Hobdey's wife has passed away. Donations to the Gooding Education Foundation have been suggested. Motion was made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by J Chambers to send a \$50.00 donation in Mary Hobdey's name. All in favorer and the motion carried.

Motion made by J. Rodgers ad 2<sup>nd</sup> by J. Chambers to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the meeting adjourned at 7:45 P.M.
