

REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
DIETRICH, IDAHO
JULY 7, 2008

The Dietrich City Council met in regular session at Dietrich City Hall. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Don Heiken at 7:00 P.M. Roll was called and those answering present were: Jim Rodgers, Jeanette Chambers, Daryl Ballard, and Tracy Perron. Also attending the meeting was Donna Greenfield, Jeremy Sousercallins from Idaho Foster Care, Mark Stevenson, and Betty Peyman.

Jeremy Sousercallins from Idaho Foster Care Program attended the meeting to explain about foster care in Idaho and the need for more Foster Families. He informed the council who to contact if anyone is interested in becoming a foster parent. Some of the qualifications would be having enough room, no guns that are not under lock and key, finances for own needs, and have a back ground check.

A Foster Care Training session will be held in Shoshone on August 26, 2008. He will send more information about the place and time. He also requested that some information be sent in the next water billing. Some information is supposed to be sent to the city.

Donna Greenfield attended about the road to Greg Greenfield's home. The water running from above has made large ruts in the road. The grate over the water basin becomes plugged up and causes to the water to run down the road. The council informed Mrs. Greenfield that they do have plans for grading the road and putting some gravel on it.

Mark Stevenson told council that he had talked to the DEQ about the problem in his back yard with sewage. He stated his neighbors above him are not on city sewer and when a lot of people are living in the one house above his property he has more problems with the leakage into his yard. The DEQ told him to talk to the council and if the problem could not be resolved to contact South Central Health Dept.

City clerk needs to write a letter to the Hansen's to hook up to the city sewer.

Motion was made by J. Chambers and 2nd by J. Rodgers to write a letter to Hansen's concerning hook up to city sewer. All in favor and the motion carried.

Mayor Heiken and Tom Young will check out the problem tomorrow.

Betty Peyman told the council that the work on the water for 410 N. Washington, has been taking a long time to get installed. She wondered if Rick Hiatt is busy if the city could have a back up person with a backhoe to put in the line.

Council discussed some options but no decision has been made about what to do.

Motion was made by T. Perron and 2nd by J. Rodgers to approve the minutes as read. All in favor and the motion carried.

Speed Limit signs from Prison Industries-34.00 a piece, from the State of Idaho Highway Department-\$22.00 for posts and signs are \$15.00 a piece.

Council suggested using conduit 2" pipe for putting up signs. Council decided to get the speed limit signs from State Department in Shoshone with the cost of approximately \$156.00.

Mr. Young told the council that there was nothing wrong with the brakes on the truck. The brake cylinder adjuster was bad.

Hooks for tennis court- Councilman Ballard has hooks for the fence.

Ramps were bought for the truck from Wal-Mart.

Hinges on the pickup truck door need to be replaced and need a new latch for the door. Councilman Rodgers may have some.

New business: The Dietrich Fire Department does not like the city to still be charging for electricity. They want to know why we are still charging when they don't feel that they are using any electricity.

Motion was made by J. Rodgers and 2nd by T. Perron to write a letter to the Fire Department stating that the new council wants to look at rental of building a re-evaluate continued use of the city facility.

Motion by T. Perron and 2nd by J. Chambers to table until next meeting. All in favor and motion carried.

Discussion was made on water ordinances and other ordinances. Council needs to have a work session on the ordinances to see where amendments need to be made to the ordinances.

Ordinance for Impact Fees tabled.

The council discussed getting some pallets to put pipes that are on the school property. The pallets will be used to set the pipes on at the lagoons.

There is a Founders Fair and Mayor Heiken plans on to attend.

Motion made by J. Rodgers and 2nd by T. Perron to table all ordinances until next meeting and councilpersons have had a chance to look at the various ordinances. All in favor and the motion carried.

A report from Tom Young also included a meter is needed at Dietrich Highway District Shop. A back flow preventor also needs to be tested.

Still need some new tires for the generator and T. Young will purchase them.

A jack and lug wrench also needs to be purchased for the pick up.

A meter for the hydrant by Highway shop needs to be installed on the fire hydrant so we can keep track of water taken from the hydrant.

No motion was made to purchase the meters.

The ditch water pipe at the north end of the park is plugged. Mayor Heiken borrowed the Pressure Truck from Richfield but was not able to get all the way through the line. Something needs to be done to open up the ditch line and fix the plug.

The city clerk presented the proposed budget for 2008-2009. **Motion** made by the J. Rodgers and 2nd by T. Perron to accept the proposed budget for publication. All in favor and the motion carried.

Councilman T. Perron wants to look into selling the bond.

Motion made by T. Perron and 2nd by J. Chambers to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the meeting adjourned at 9:30 P.M.
