Dakota Norman presented the council with an idea for an Eagle Scout Project. He wants to put in a horseshoe pit at the city park. His scout troop will help him put it in. Some of materials he is getting donated such as tires and sand. Rods still need to be found for the stakes. One choice for a location would be below tennis court and the other choice would be along the tennis court by Park Street. Needs to get project approved through his scout council as an Eagle Scout Project.

Council approved the plan and decided that the location along Park Street would be the best because not as many people use the area to walk across to the park building.

Tyrell Porter also wants to do something with the new playground equipment area for his Eagle Scout Project. Councilperson Towne will need to get with him about what to install in area where equipment will go.

Elenora Price attended to discuss her sewer bill. Had question on the bill and the cost. He is to fill out a LMI form and turn it in to city hall to see if she qualifies for Low to Moderate-Income status.

Tom Young gave a report on the work that he has been doing. Read all the meters except for ones that need to be excavated. Discussed different approaches to digging out water meters. Discussed dial up at the well and probably another channel needs to come in for the printer to record pump activity. He also needs to work on the phone system at the well to set it for calling if there is a problem at the well. Meter reading was also discussed and when to start reading them.

Council expressed how pleased they are at the work he has been doing for the city.

Step bills for Rick Hiatt were approved at the last meeting. Need to get Mr. Hiatt some money.

Financial meeting estimated needs to have engineer for financial status. Councilman Southwick read a letter from Forsgren for finishing the project with a contractor estimated cost to be \$242,000.00 with the city doing the contracting it was estimated to be about \$205,000.00. The engineering fee would be about \$40,000.00 or \$30,000.00 respectively.

Letter was read from Dietrich Highway Dept. concerning payment of work. Motion made by D. Heiken and 2nd by W. Southwick to turn over the Highway Users money and the highway to city property tax money. All in favor and the motion carried.

Need to send water patrons that are in the rears a copy of the water portion of the ordinance concerning payment. If there is no response a follow up shut of notice should be sent.

Authorized Tom Young to go to the hardware store and purchase a tool to help him take the dirt out of the holes around the water meters.

New city truck is ready for use except needs an oil and lube job. Also, gauges need to be fixed so can read odometer.

W. Southwick recommended that Mr. Young be allowed to drive the truck home. Will need it for city work and won't have to drive his own vehicle.

4th of July ceremonies will be on the 3rd at city park. Don Heiken to check on afternoon lunch at park. Suggested Mayor give a speech of appreciation to Lytle Gaskill and Rick Hiatt for all the work and diligence that they have put forth on the sewer project. Need to locate a speaker system so she can be heard. Motion made by J. Towne and 2nd by W. Southwick to go in 1/2 with the fire district to buy the meat, buns, and drinks. All in favor and the motion carried.

Motion made by J. Towne and 2nd by D. Heiken to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the motion carried.
