JUNE 2, 2008

The city council met in regular session at 7:00 P.M. at Dietrich City Hall. Roll was called by Mayor D. Heiken. The council member answering present were Daryl Ballard, Jim Rodgers, and Tracy Perron. Jeanette Chambers was absent. Also attending the meeting was LuAnne Christiansen, Elnora Price and Polly Huggins from Wood River RC& D.

**Motion** was made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to approve the minutes as read. All in favor and the motion carried.

Polly Huggins project co-coordinator for the Wood River RC&D attended the meeting. She discussed the next MACC meeting which will include several banks with low interest rate loans. New business: Tires for generator-needs 2 new tires. D. Ballard will check to see if he has anything to match the tires that are already on the generator.

Someone needs to check with Luke Hubert to see if he is going to build the building for the generator.

Report from Tom Young- water was sold to Hasco Track Tech. for work on the railroad. They used about 36,000 gallons of water.

The truck needs some ramps so the lawn mower can be hauled to the well to cut the weeds and grass.

The truck needs new brakes it sounds like the rear brakes are going out. **Motion** made by J Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to call Ben's Repair and put on new brakes. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Motion** was made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to rescind the water rate motion of 2006 charging \$5.00 per thousand gallons of water. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Motion** made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to charge current rate of \$10.00 per thousand gallons of water. All in favor and the motion carried.

Need an upgrade on the memory for the computer. Probably need 128MG of upgrade. **Motion** made by D. Ballard and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to up grade the memory for the computer if J. Rodgers doesn't have any. All in favor and the motion carried.

Council seat appointment- **Motion** was made by T Perron and 2<sup>nd</sup> by J. Rodgers to appoint Daryl Ballard as President of the Council. All in favor and the motion carried.

Clerk was instructed to write a letter to Ms. Arrossa concerning her complaint on sewer bill. Ms. Arrossa will be invited to the next meeting to visit with the council concerning her complaint.

Also a letter and a phone call to Mr. Hiatt concerning Ms. Arrossa's complaint. **Motion** was made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to contact Mr. Hiatt. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Motion** made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron that the 3 months water notices is enforced. If not paid after that water will be shut off and a lien placed on the property.

Discussed redoing the water bond to get it paid off faster.

Motion was made by J. Rodgers and 2<sup>nd</sup> by T. Perron to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
