White Cloud Communications: Mayor talked to Nate from Tech Hut and they were suppose to have been up and running by the end of May.

Water Rate Study: Mayor Heiken will call Jim Phillips to see when he has dates open to come for a public hearing.

The school has been using the canal water except for one section south of the school that does not have that usage.

Disconnection of the school well has been done. The line has been capped from the school line to the city line and 2 check valves have been put in from city to school to prevent back flow. The meter has been moved to the park to monitor water there.

Noise Ordinance: Mayor Heiken presented the council members with a Noise Ordinance. A copy needs to be sent to the lawyer for approval before passage.

Recreation District: Council still has not received anything from them for the help with putting in the pavers at the park.

Ditch water at the park: As soon as a backhoe can be located, the meter and a back flow preventor will be installed.

Eagle Scout Project: Gage Roberts has been working on putting the pavers around the barbeque area.

Report from Tom Young: Robin Southwick would like to city to move the excess sewer pipe from her property. The council needs to find a loader to be able to lift the pipe.

The school wants to trade 2 months of water for use of the road grader. The council needs to find out what is wrong with the grader and what it will take to fix it.

The council would like to obtain a copy of the letter that was presented to the school board members about what sort of agreement the city had with the school concerning the water.

Ordinance for Mandatory Sewer hook up. How will the council enforce the hook up?

Council discussed the presentation by Keller and Associates. There is still one more engineering firm to be interviewed.

A motion was made by C. Anderson and 2nd by J. Chambers to add the \$200.00 bill for the MACC. All in favor and the motion carried.

A motion was made by D. Ballard and 2nd by J. Chambers to adjourn the meeting. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned at 9:00 P.M.
