Jerry Heimerdinger and Lyle Towne attending the meeting to ask if the city would be willing to pay half of the bill for the lift station. Motion was made by Heiken and 2<sup>nd</sup> by R. Smith for the city to pay half of the lift station charge. All in favor and the motion carried.

Also the work that the Highway District does for the city was discussed. Things like patching and they have just been doing. They were asked to get a hold of Don Heiken before things are done for approval by the city.

Eagle Scout project tabled. Councilman Smith will talk to Luke Hubert about what he is going to do.

The snowplowing truck needs to be fixed to plow snow. It was suggested putting a couple of cement blocks on the bed to add weight until a truck bed can be found to go on it. The snow plow is already on the truck.

Call engineer and find out what the cost of the O & M Manuel will be and find out what is left on the project.

Report on contact with attorney. Councilman Heiken talked to Mr. Hobdey about Acey Shaw's request to hook to city water and sewer services. Councilman Heiken or Mr. Hobdey could not find anything in the ordinance that said we couldn't hook him to city services.

The person that was to be appointed to the 2 year council position has moved out of the city. The council needs to find another person to fill that position.

New business: Motion by A. Eschliman and 2<sup>nd</sup> by R. Smith to appoint Harold Chambers and Lois Stoddard to another term on the P & Z Commission. All in favor and the motion carried.

Council discussed a raise for the clerk. Discussed what her wages are and also that the city needs a pay scale. Motion was made by D. Heiken and 2<sup>nd</sup> by R. Smith to raise the clerk's wages to \$12.50 and hour until rate study is done. All in favor and the motion carried.

Report from Tom Young: Mr. Young showed the council accumulation of cost for power for a year for city hall. He demonstrated how he came to the conclusion of what to charge the fire district for power.

Motion was made by A. Eschliman and 2<sup>nd</sup> by R. Smith that the Fire District should pay 70% of the bill for city hall. All in favor and the motion carried.

Mr. Young replaced a water meter at Ruben Rivas house.

Tires: Three quotes were received for tires. Ben's Repair quoted us \$655.00, Les Schwab's quote was \$685.00, and Wal Mart quoted the city \$487.00. Motion was made by R. Smith and 2<sup>nd</sup> by A. Eschliman to purchase tires from Wal Mart. All in favor and the motion carried.

A jack is also need for the truck and a lug wrench.

Councilman Heiken and Tom Young cleaned the ditch and the park and poured cement. Used a plastic bucket and pipe down in the ditch and put a lid over the cement to keep people from getting into the hole.

Set post for gate at the well and some holes need to be drilled for bolts.

Council will come to city hall at 8:15 on November 6 to canvas the votes.

Motion made by Heiken and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Smith to adjourn the meeting. All in favor and the motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 8:15 P.M.
