OLD BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

Pat Baker with ICRIMP ~ Pat went over the insurance and it was decided that Tom and Iva Lee will review the items listed and make the necessary changes with Pat.

Lyle talked about the road between Washington and Wauconda The ditch for Ron Beckley needs fixed. We need fill dirt and gravel. Lyle said that 600 ft of gravel would cost about \$1500. We need to work on getting property owners to release an easement to establish the road. We need to talk to Ron Beckley about his agreement with the city over his irrigation ditch. Will work on getting more information.

Lyle said that the Highway department is going to sell the snowplow truck that we have been using and we could put in a bid if we want to.

Tom Young

Tom reports that the north lagoon is turning green with algae. He talked to Tony Elfini (IRWA) about corrections to the lagoon. Tom has concerns over dumping in the lagoons and the RV dumping station. Tom will talk to Tony about these to explore our options. Water is being pumped from the hydrant by the Hwy department for the beet dump. Tom will get a price on a back flow preventer and meter for this hydrant.

The end hydrant needs backfilled. Fred will check to see if we can use the dirt at the lagoon.

The generator trailer needs new tires 215-75R15

We need grade rings and lid at the SE corner.

Tom will make a list at City Hall for needs to finish the sewer project.

The hydrant at the Church needs fixed, it was leaking and is turned off at this time.

The new counter at the well is not working; Tom called Roberts Electric to get them out to fix it.

Don gave the council information about the Government Investment Pool and the council suggested having Diane set it up when she sets up the accounting procedures.

Don motioned to adjourn at 8:35 PM the motion was seconded by Ryan.
