The City Council met in special session at 8:30 P.M. at city hall. Roll was called by Mayor Knowles: J. Towne, present, D. Heiken, present, W. Southwick, present, and W. Perron, absent.

There were no addition to the agenda.

Linda from Senator Crapo's office said need to get estimate from the engineer on how much it will take to finish the project and fax it to her.

In order to get the engineer report we have to make a commitment for a monthly payment to start paying for their back services. Motion made by Southwick and 2nd by Heiken to pay Forsgren \$250.00 and \$50.00 per month to Skinner Fawcett along with letters that tells them what we are going to do. All in favor and the motion carried

Included in the letter will be information on Rural Developments suggestion that we offer a 10% discount to people paying their sewer accounts in full.

Discussed putting telephone back on line at the well and hooking up the printer to the well.

Discussed need to establish some type of water schedule for the city water.

Pump for water system so the meters can be pumped out and read.

Economic Development Rural Economic is submitting and application to get funded for 3 years. If we can show we are part of the group it is easier to apply for grants. It was recommended that we stay with them and commit \$200.00 additional money. The motion was made by J. Towne and 2nd by D. Heiken to go with the recommendation. All in favor and the motion carried.
