

Cross Connection Control Ordinance


The City of Dietrich Idaho's water system will be operated in a manner as prescribed by the Department of Environmental Quality's rules for water system operation in regard to cross connection control. Suitable backflow prevention devices are required wherever there is a cross connection that has the potential to allow anything to backflow into the city's drinking water system. Examples of cross connections are: lawn sprinkler systems, fire sprinkler systems, boilers, soda pop dispensers, animal watering devices, and so on.

Backflow prevention devices are to be tested once a year by a licensed backflow prevention device tester. Any person who fails to comply with this ordinance will have their water service terminated until such time as they satisfy the city they have come into compliance.
