

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF DIETRICH, IDAHO REQUESTING USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT AND RURAL COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE CORPORATION TO ASSIST IN DOING A RATE STUDY FOR SEWER AND WATER.

WHEREAS, The City of Dietrich is a small rural municipality located in the State of Idaho; and,


WHEREAS, the City of Dietrich owns its water and sewer systems, but lacks sufficient funds or expertise to evaluate the rate structure for such systems; and,


WHEREAS, the Dietrich City Council finds that it would be in the best interests of the City of Dietrich to request the assistance of USDA RURAL DEVELOPMENT and RURAL COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE CORPORATION in funding a rate study for sewer and water.
