Conditions of Approval:

1. 26A Project construction shall commence within one year from the date of permit issuance and shall proceed diligently to completion unless it can be shown to the satisfaction of the Director of the Department of Water Resources that delays were due to circumstances over which the permit holder had no control.
2. 046 Right holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Section 42-235, Idaho Code and applicable Well Construction Rules of the Department.
3. R05 Use of water under this right will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District 130.
4. 126 Place of use is within the service area of the City of Dietrich municipal water supply system as provided for under Idaho law.
5. 180 A map depicting the place of use boundary for this water right at the time of this approval is attached to this document for illustrative purposes.
6. 139 Prior to any diversion and use of water under this water right, the right holder shall (1) provide evidence of participation in a mitigation plan, approved by the director, and administered by a ground water district or other recognized organization, or (2) provide individual mitigation approved by the director.
7. 212 Prior to diversion and use of water under this approval, the right holder shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s) at the authorized point(s) of diversion, in accordance with Department specifications.
8. 213 Upon specific notification of the Department, the right holder shall install and maintain data loggers to record water usage information at the authorized point(s) of diversion in

- accordance with Department specifications.
9. 075 Irrigation of large projects such as parks, golf courses, or sports activities fields is not authorized under this right.
10. 022 The daily diversion volume for non-domestic uses under this municipal right shall not exceed 2,500 gallons per use and the daily diversion volume for domestic uses under this right shall not exceed 13,000 gallons per dwelling in accordance with Section 42-111, Idaho Code.
11. R55 This right is for the use of trust water and is subject to review 20 years after the issuance of the permit to determine availability of water and to re-evaluate the public interest.
12. 140 Noncompliance with any condition of this right, including the requirement for mitigation, is cause for the director to issue a notice of violation, cancel or revoke the right, or, if the right is included in a water district, request that the watermaster curtail diversion and use of water.
